MYDDLE, BROUGHTON & HARMER HILL

ACTION PLAN 2016 - 2017

The Council will:

- 1. Maintain strict control over expenditure to ensure that parishioners get value for their Council Tax payment.
- 2. Ensure that the Council continually works to develop and maintain the aims stated in the Council's Mission Statement.
- 3. Encourage members of the public to attend Council meetings and bring issues of concern to the attention of Councillors.
- 4. Monitor and respond to all planning applications, in line with those ideals stated in the published Parish Plan and to identify and attempt to meet the needs of those seeking affordable housing.
- 5. Continue to liaise with and put pressure on Shropshire Council, with regard to road safety issues highlighted by residents and Members of the Parish Council. These will include:
 - (a) Improved road safety measures for children attending Myddle School.
 - (b) Speed restriction measures on Myddle Hill.
 - (c) Vehicle operated speed controls on roads entering Harmer Hill from Wem and Shrewsbury.
 - (d) Improved footpaths on Ellesmere Road, Harmer Hill.
 - (e) Safety issues on The Hollow and Lower Road, Harmer Hill.
- 6. Provide grant aid to both Village Halls for community activity.
- 7. Give small grants to local/national charities which provide assistance to local residents.
- 8. Attempt to secure finance to provide a bus shelter in Myddle for children awaiting transport to secondary education centres.
- Work closely with a small committee seeking to renovate the Parish War Memorial.
- 10. Ensure that the Children's Play Area is maintained to a high standard and to seek financial support to provide extensions and create an improved pathway to it from Myddle Village.
- 11. To create a Children's Play Area in Harmer Hill
- 12. Continue to monitor and respond to issues raised in the Community Led Plan and work with members of the committee to review the plan.

- 13. Encourage Members to attend recognised training opportunities and support the Clerk in the provision of a professional service.
- 14. Maintain strong links with the police to ensure that there is a continued low level of crime in the parish.
- 15. Continue to ensure that regular news items are published on the web site and in the Messenger and when appropriate, passed to the local press.
