Earlier this year a dedicated team of volunteers, with the financial support of Shropshire Community Council, produced the Myddle and Broughton Parish Community Led Plan. The Plan, which has raised many issues and concerns, has been widely distributed in the community and it is the intention of the Parish council to keep you up to date with the progress of dealing with those issues, with articles in the Messenger and regular updates on the Council's web site.

We are pleased to report that the Parish Council and Shropshire Council have both adopted the report in its entirety and individual Parish Councillors, under the leadership of Bob Jeffrey the Chairman, have agreed to oversee various sections of the plan. These include Housing and Building Development; Traffic and Road Safety; Community Activities; Services; the Environment and Business Development. If you have any comments or concerns about any of these activities or want more information, please let the Parish Clerk know and he will pass the details on to the relevant Councillors.

Already the Council has produced a policy for housing development over the next fifteen years and this has been accepted by Shropshire Council and included in its development plans. Details of this are available on the web site www.myddleandbroughton-pc.gov.uk or can be obtained from the Clerk.

A forthcoming edition of the Messenger will include details of all the Clubs and Societies in the Parish; pressure is being put on the relevant bodies to obtain faster broadband and efforts are being made to deal with concerns and dangers related to the speed, volume and the size of vehicles travelling on the Parish roads.

Council Members accept that this is a huge opportunity to make a visible difference in the community and will do their utmost to deal with the recommendations highlighted in the Plan.
