Members are delighted to report that Shropshire Council has agreed to the Parish Council's request to have the name of the Parish Council changed to Myddle, Broughton and Harmer Hill Parish Council.

The idea to ask for a change was instigated by Bob Jeffrey, the Council Chairman, who felt that it was important to acknowledge the importance of the Harmer Hill residents within the community served by the Parish Council.

Before approaching Shropshire Council the possible change was discussed at several Council meetings and gained a good deal of support from residents and unanimous support from Members.

Council Members have been involved in protracted discussions with the Safer Road partnership over the many concerns brought to their attention about speeding traffic throughout the parish.

At the Council's request, a number of covert checks were carried out and it was discovered that on several roads the average speed recorded was well above the stated limit. As a result both the Safer Road Partnership and the Police will be targetting these roads over the next few months.
