4. Witterage Cottage, Houlston Lane, Myddle erection of a detached storage building (22/03519/FUL). *No objections raised.*
5. 5, Wood Terrace, Myddlewood – application under 73a Town & Country Planning Act for retrospective change of use on a holiday let to unrestricted residential dwelling. (20/03519/FUL). *Objections raised based on comments made by the Planning Department regarding previous applications at this site.*
6. Alder Cottage, Myddlewood – Erection of rear and side extensions and interior re-modelling (22/03625/FUL).
7. Woodside, Yorton – change of use agricultural land to a site for two caravans, including alterations to access, parking and drainage (22/03468/FUL).
